## TOOL DEFINITIONS

(continued)

**BAND SAW:** A large stationary power saw primarily used by most shops to cut large pieces into smaller pieces that more easily fit into the trash after you cut on the inside of the line instead of the outside edge. Also excels at amputations.

**TWO-TON ENGINE HOIST:** A tool for testing the maximum tensile strength of all the things you forgot to disconnect.

**PHILLIPS SCREWDRIVER:** Normally used to stab the vacuum seals under lids or for opening but can also be used, as the name implies, to strip out Phillips screw heads and also used in place of a punch.

**STRAIGHT SCREWDRIVER:** A tool for opening paint cans. Sometimes used to convert common slotted screws into non-removable screws. Also sometimes used as a chisel or a gasket surface scraper.

**PRY BAR:** A tool used to crumple the metal surrounding that clip or bracket you needed to remove in order to replace an inexpensive part.
