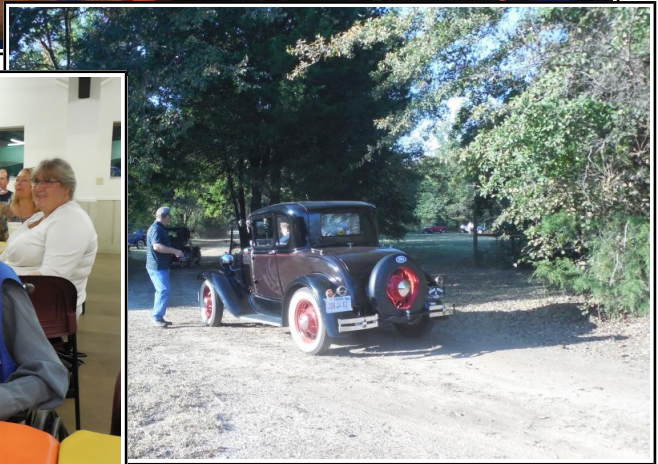

TOOL DEFINITIONS
(continued)

PVC PIPE CUTTER: A tool used to make plastic pipe too short.
