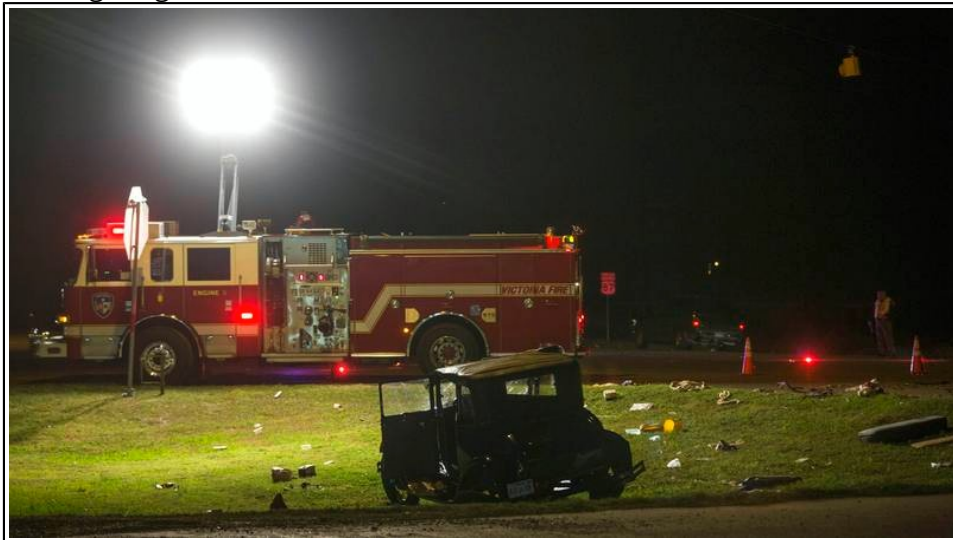
Shorty continues to grow weaker..he is in CHF. Please keep me and our family in your thoughts and prayers. Thanks!

Please contribute, don't always leave it to only one or two folks to do it all.



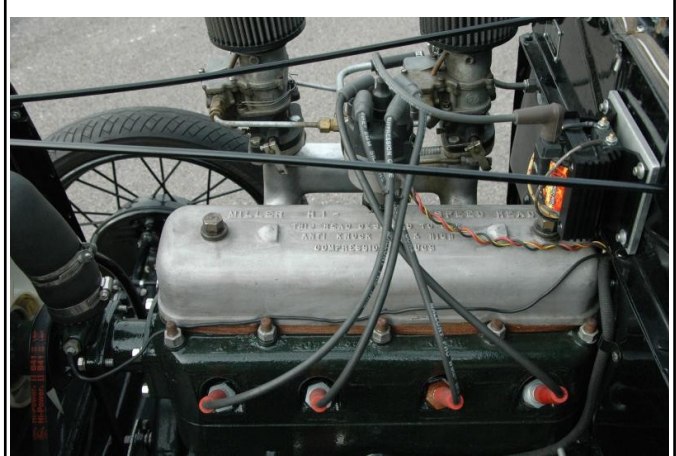

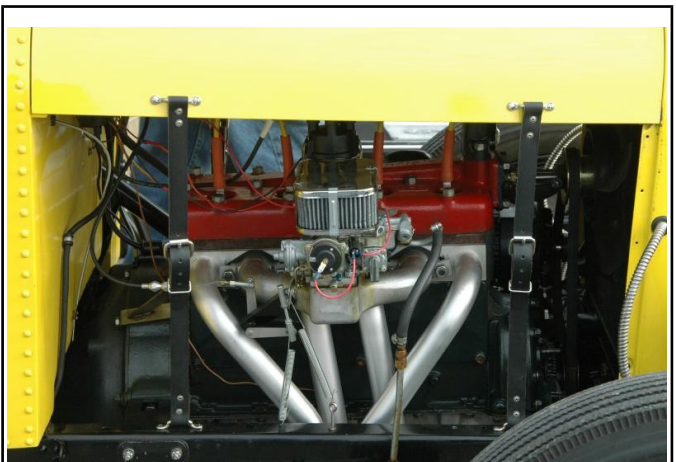
