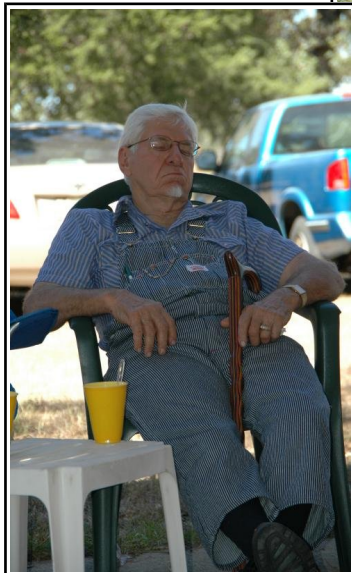
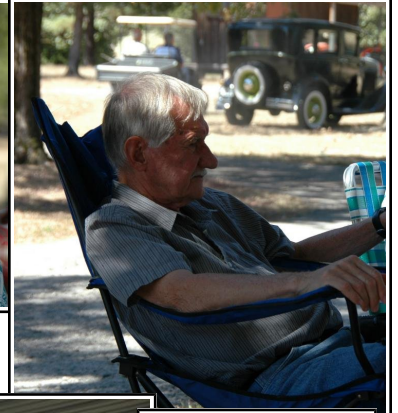
## **Tuesday Breakfast Yellow Rose Cafe – Seven Points October 20, 2015**

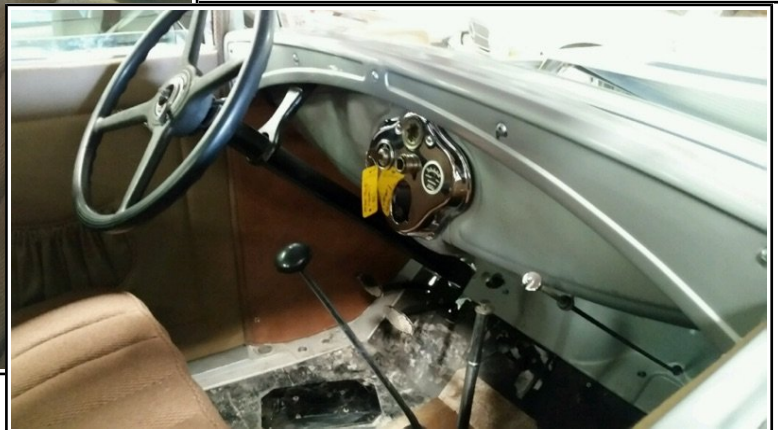
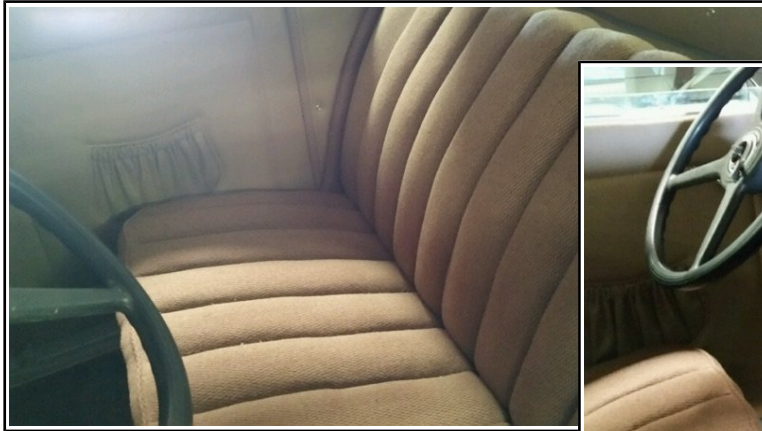
