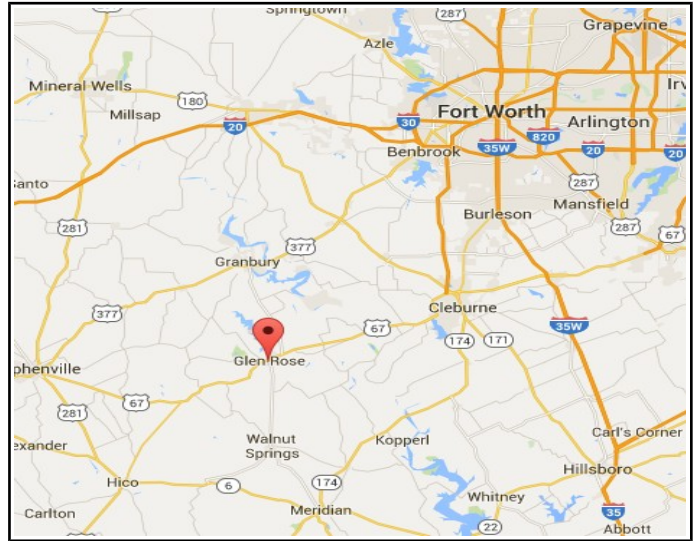

The **raffle** drawing was won by Billy Carpenter.

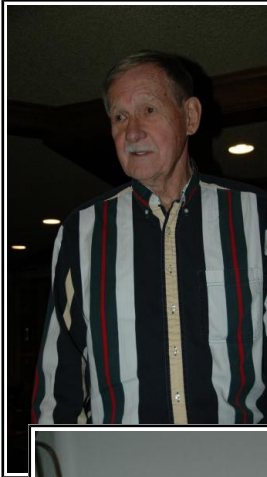
Walt made the **motion to adjourn**. Seconded by Joe.
