The Wayward Webmaster Redux

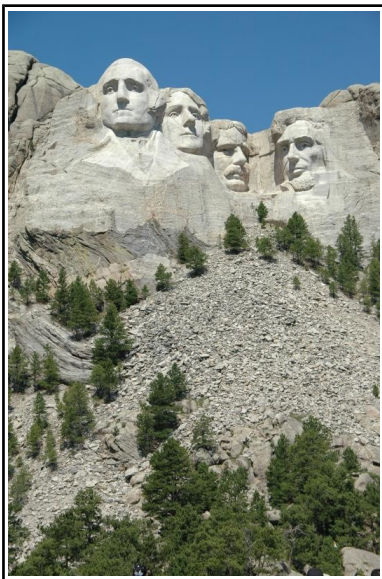
A great big word of thanks to Lou Carpenter for taking over the newsletter once again while Sandra and I enjoyed a month-long RV trip.

From there to Mt. Rushmore. Given the situation our nation faces today, this was a sobering visit, reminding us of what we are about to perhaps lose.

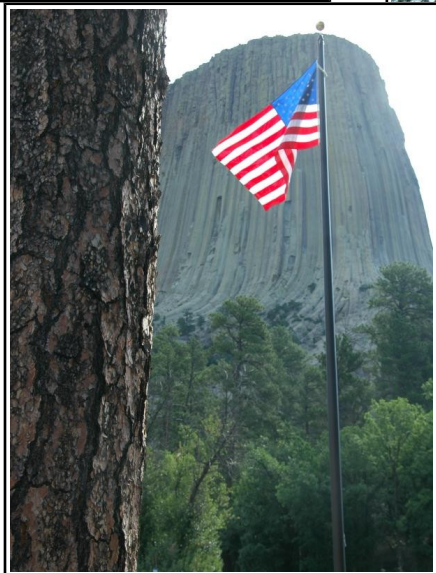
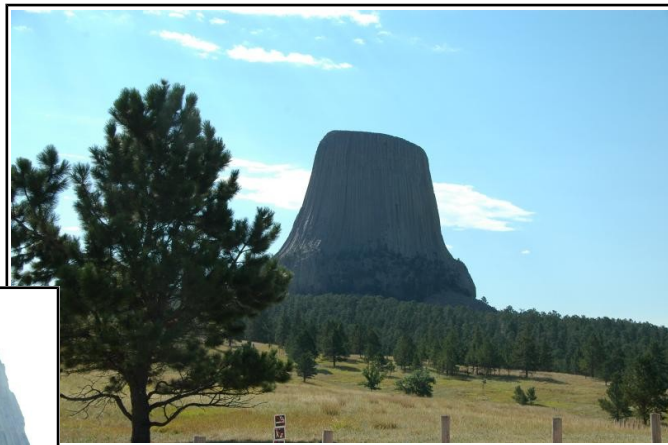


Redux – continued

IMAD 2016

International Model A Day will be celebrated world-wide on September 10. Our club will be hosting a driving tour that day. Walt, Lou, Jodi and Sue have put together a great tour. The instructions for the tour are as follows:

Cedar Creek members will meet in Gun Barrel City at Vetoni's. We plan to leave **promptly at 8 am.**

We will go North on 198 to the Hwy 90 exit on the LEFT at the Comfort Suites.

We will pick up the Letchworths and Carpenters on Hwy 90.

We will turn RIGHT at Praireville on 90 making a sharp RIGHT to 2702.

Proceed to 2703

Turn LEFT on 2703 go to HWY 47. Turn LEFT on 47

Turn RIGHT onto 1651. To Whitton

STOP in Jackson at 198.

Turn LEFT onto 198 toward Canton.

Cross over Hwy 243

Proceed to the north side of the square.

Turn LEFT on Hwy 64 to 859 (about 1/2 mile)

Turn RIGHT.

The Edgewood Baptist Church is on the corner of 859 and Hwy 80 .

We will meet the Autumn Trails members who live there at the church about [9 am](#).

We will leave from the church parking lot located on the Right hand side of the road.

Head on down Hwy 80 to Grand Saline and Mineola (23 miles)

Autumn Trails members who live in that area will meet us on Hwy 80

We plan to arrive in Mineola about [9:45 am](#)

Some members may want to meet us in Mineola at the train depot parking lot.

We will park there to tour the local shops and area of Mineola.

We will depart from the train parking lot [at 11:45 am](#) and drive to the Civic Center for lunch.

We will go North on Hwy 69 (which is Pacific St)

From the traffic light go [7 blocks to Cage St.](#)

[Turn RIGHT.](#) Go 1 block to Newsom

Turn LEFT to the Civic Center..parking on the RIGHT

LUNCH will be served at the Civic Center in Mineola promptly [at 12 noon](#)

We will be at the Civic Center [from 12-1pm](#).

Leaving the Civic Center [at 1:00](#) heading to Lindale to the Old Mill Pond Museum for a tour.

We plan to arrive at the Old Mill Pond Museum [at 1:30pm](#).

Our plan to to tour the museum on your own for 1 hour.

This will be the end of the tour.. Other club members: plan your routes home from Lindale. Cedar Creek members will return home thru Edom.
