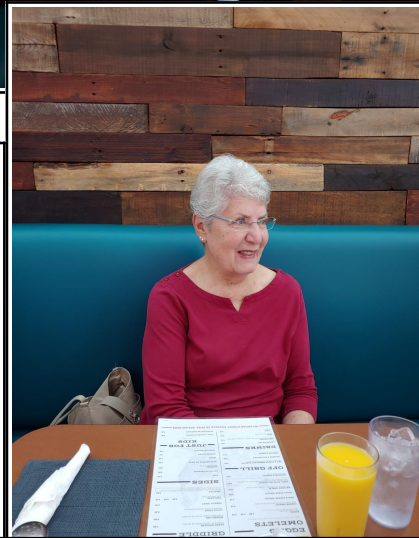

Metal Rescue – a chemical de-rusting product

Early this year, Sherri Hicks of Workshop Hero, manufacturer of Metal Rescue, sent a demonstration packet of their product. I finally found my lone round tuit and tried the product out. Summary: it works. No, it's not magic and it does still require work to make things right, but it eases the process of rust removal on steel or iron parts.



I got a small collection of rusted parts from Ken Parker and added a rear bumper that had rust spots on it. You can see in the pictures what it was.



The product was both a bath for soaking and small packs of jell that you apply on a surface and then wrap in plastic wrap. The stuff turns black as it works and must be washed off with water when done.

Then, parts that are a lot of bare steel need to be sprayed with their Dry Coat that leaves a protective film to prevent re-rusting of the parts.

And the pictures certainly confirm their instructions that heavy rust must be first removed manually, that grease and paint as well since where those are on a part, the chemical does not work if there is rust beneath. You can see in the pictures some heavy rust items that didn't get sparkling clean, as expected
